



TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given that Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order as detailed below:

Nature of Restriction: Temporary Speed Limit Reduction from 60mph to 40mph/20mph

Location: Abingdon Road, Clifton Hampden, Abingdon, Oxfordshire.

Speed restriction from 60mph to 40mph from outside the property known as South Cottage to junction with High Street. A distance of approximately 322 metres.

Speed restriction from 60mph to 20mph from junction with High Street to the junction with Thame Lane. A distance of approximately 414 metres.

Description of Works: Temporary speed limit reduction on the A415 to allow safe construction vehicle access to Thame Lane to support works associated with the HIF1 project. Works being carried out by Oxfordshire County Council.

The anticipated completion date is 31/08/2027 23:59 (inclusive)
